Every musician-performer begins the rehearsals by carefully tuning the instrument and performing the chigilozdi exercises, but the position of the performer and the incorrect placement of the fingers will cause difficulties for the performer in the future. In music - there are a variety of gammas and etudes, based on the application of a certain technical method of instrumental performance and designed to improve the skills of the musician. Nowadays, the role of etude and gamma exercises in the performance of folk instruments is of special importance.

I have been teaching for almost 40 years. I love my profession and remain committed to it because I have achieved so many positive results during this period. At the heart of this is honest work, and I am proud of it.

Among my students there are mature artists, talented teachers, executives, people who work effectively in various fields, who are passionate about art,
